RULES AND INFORMATION:

- High Schools with a total population of 500 students or less will be allowed to participate. Definition of High School is 9-12 grades. However, if your music program includes 7th -12th grades students they may participate (students in the 7th and 8th grade at the end of the 2012 school year.)
 - ▲ Judging will be based on the following:
 - (1) Music Execution & Interpretation
 - (2) Marching
 - (3) General Appearance & Audience Appeal
- Bands will stop at the judging station the first time around the parade route. This will be the <u>ONLY</u> time bands can stop and play.
- Bands will play <u>but not stop</u> in front of the judging station the second time through the parade route. Stopping the second time through will result in disqualification.
- Bands are asked to play their song no less than two times each time around the parade route.
- Judging sheets will be mailed approximately 15 days after the Festival.
- Awards will be announced at VIP After Party at approximately 1:30 PM. \$2,000 first place \$500 second place. Checks will be sent to winners with judging sheets.
- We are requiring that you include a contact cell phone number so we can easily contact you the day of the event.
- Directions, parking information, line up details and your line up number will be sent to you 15 days prior to the parade. If you have any questions, contact Jess Rich at 218-591-4333.
- Registration must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2012 limited to the first 10 registrations received.
- All funds will be returned in the event of inclement weather.
