About the Competition

A maximum of 20 bands will compete, based on entry postmark. There will be preliminary awards in three or four class divisions based upon the size and number of bands in attendance. (There were four classes in 2011.)

Classification System

A = up to 30 winds B = 31 - 50 winds C = 51 - 70 winds (or more*) D = 71 or more winds *Class D will be added if attendance warrants

Preliminary Field Competition

Trophies awarded for top three bands in each class. Caption Awards in each class for Outstanding Percussion, Color Guard, Drum Majors, Music, Marching and General Effect.

Open Class Final Field Competition

Finalist bands will be the top eight or ten preliminary scores (depending on whether there are three or four divisions).

All finalists bands will receive a place trophy.

Grand Champion caption awards for: Percussion, Color Guard, Drum Majors, Music, Marching and General Effect.
